We are here for the youth seeking guidance, the aspiring leaders needing direction, and the young minds eager for a space where their voices are heard and valued. Simultaneously, we are for adults who wish to contribute positively to the next generation, offering them a structured path to become impactful mentors in their communities.

In a world where the mainstream education system and youth industry often follow a one-size-fits-all approach, countless young individuals find themselves at a crossroads, overlooked and underserved. These systems, while well-intentioned, sometimes fail to accommodate the diverse needs, backgrounds, and learning styles of all youth. As a result, many young people fall through the cracks, lost in a maze of unmet potential and unaddressed challenges. This gap in the system is where **MANA Youth Project** positions itself as a crucial intervention.

THE CRACKS IN MAINSTREAM SYSTEMS

The mainstream education system, with its focus on standardised testing and uniform curricula, often misses out on nurturing individual talents and addressing unique learning needs. Similarly, the broader youth industry can overlook personal mentorship, leaving young individuals without the guidance and actionable support they need during their formative years. These "cracks" manifest as feelings of disconnection, underachievement, and a lack of direction, particularly impacting those from marginalised or less privileged backgrounds. This is the first stage of the Modern Heroes Journey: Recognition of the Ordinary World.

Archetypal Psychology,
and the Socrative
Method of Inquiry.

- It allows young people to explore and make sense of their personal experiences, emotions, and identity, empowering them with critical thinking skills and a deeper understanding of themselves and the world around them.
- The framework encourages young people to appreciate the different stages of their personal journey, recognise the archetypes within themselves, and engage in meaningful dialogue with their mentors.
- This approach fosters selfawareness, confidence, and resilience.

MENTOR TRAINING

Utilising our own Narrative Mentorship Framework we possess a unique platform to train Mentors in communities not only in Australia, but across the world.

By keeping our Framework customisable and not wrapped in academic jargon and country based statistics, we are able to work closely with cultures and communities from all diverse backgrounds by instead relying on experience and qualitative engagement, in other words, our Mentors are on the ground, doing the work, not just talking about what is best for others.

By integrating cultural awareness into our training, we can train Mentors from all walks of life, experience, qualifications, cultures and countries.

CORE PROGRAMS

Our Core Mentorship Program: The Pathfinder Program is a unique and immersive personalised Heroes Journey for Modern young people, especially those who may not fit into the boxes mainstream services and education put them in.

For out of the box thinkers, creative individuals, neurodiverse young people in mainstream and homeschool education, the Pathfinder Program has been custom built from the ground up to take each individual on a journey of self-discovery, self-actualisation and prosocial development.

Our Pathfinder Program is like literally playing a Pen & Paper Role-Playing Game where they create a Character and begin to Level Up in Life as they unlock their potential and foster the already present heroic aspects of their unique identity. Mentorship and the Mentor are just the platforms for this transformative change to take place.



CONNECT WITH A MENTOR IN YOUR COMMUNITY

The most important aspect of both our NMF Framework and Program, without this core connection, nothing else would exist. The Mentor is an adult in the community who has knowledge and practical wisdom to impart on a Mentee in need of Emotional, Mental or Social support.



UNLOCK YOUR POTENTIAL & EMBRACE YOUR PERSONAL LEGEND

The Pathfinder Program is an immersive and creative curriculum. Each student will learn new aspects about themselves and the world around them including:



- Choosing an Archetype with it's own Character Strengths, Values, Challenges & Motives that they can template from.
- Expanding awareness of the positive and negative social connections in their life.
- Discovering a Purpose distilled from a new awareness of their Virtues, Connections, Hobbies & Focus in Life.
- Authoring a new narrative that focuses on a future that they are in control of.









TACKLING THE BULLYING PROBLEM THE RESTORATIVE WAY

The B.R.A.V.E. (Bullying Resistance, Anti-Violence Education) Program was developed by MANA Youth Project for Secondary Schools.

It is unique in that it can be adjusted for each schools unique needs and student population while not editing or padding out any of the more serious issues and language associated with bullying.

It is a program aimed at bullying prevention and intervention, and will work towards enriching and evolving the schools already existing bullying policies and restorative practices, or if not present will work to help establish a new framework.

A NEW APPROACH FOR AN EVER EVOLVING PROBLEM

The program is designed to educate high school students on various aspects of Bullying Behaviours:

- Different forms of bullying: Physical & Online Cyber Bullying within a school environment.
- The tools and resources they need to prevent and intervene in bullying situations safely within the school grounds and in their own social circles.
- The difference between Reporting & Snitching, and how being an **Upstander instead of a Bystander** can be beneficial for everyone.


The main purpose of B.R.A.V.E is to separate the student from the Bully. By changing the language around bullying we can further work towards a new strategy where both parties on either side can create a culture of understanding, empathy and action.

*Some of the resources including videos and conversations can include audio/visual taken from various sources and may contain mild language.

A ROUND-TABLE, NOT A LONG ONE

A Round-Table Organizational Structure involves all members of the organization participating equally in decision-making processes, symbolizing equal status and the importance of every member's contributions, inspired by the concept of a round table. For MANA Youth Project, although their is a "Ranking" system, it merely highlights experience and time spent within the organisation.

MASTER RANK



Key features of this structure include:

- Equal Footing: All members have an equal say in discussions, ideas and promoting a democratic approach to management.
- Collaboration: This structure encourages open dialogue and teamwork, as members work together to reach consensus.
- Flat Hierarchy: There is typically a minimal or non-existent hierarchical structure, which reduces power distance between members.
- Flexibility: The structure allows for adaptable and dynamic decision-making, as it is not bound by rigid hierarchical protocols.
- Innovation and Creativity: By valuing each member's input, this structure fosters a creative environment where diverse ideas are welcomed.

INITIATE RANK

Responsibilities

- Engage in basic training modules covering the NMF, Pathfinder, and mentoring techniques.
- Shadow experienced mentors to observe effective mentoring practices.
- Conduct supervised mentorship sessions with young people.
- Regular documentation of experiences and learning in a Mentor Journal.

APPRENTICE RANK

Responsibilities

- Manage up to 3 concurrent mentorships.
- Develop individualised mentorship plans for each mentee post Pathfinder Cycle.
- Contribute to community outreach and program feedback.
- Deliver In-School Mentorship Programs alongside supervised Mentor.

JOURNEYMAN RANK

Responsibilities

- Manage up to 5 concurrent mentorships.
- Handle complex and diverse mentorship cases.
- Provide guidance and support to Apprentice Mentors.
- Lead small mentorship projects or initiatives.
- Travel between Mentorship Bureaus to train Mentors.

VETERAN RANK

Responsibilities

- Manage up to 10 concurrent mentorships.
- Conduct mentorships with a high degree of autonomy.
- Innovate and pilot new mentoring techniques or programs.
- Provide strategic input to MANA Youth Project leadership.

MASTER RANK

 Oversee strategic direction of the mentorship program. Foster a culture of excellence and innovation. Act as a guide and advisor for lower ranks and Expert Mentors. Oversee the establishment and/or operation of a Mentor Bureau.

BUREAU OVERSEER

- Usually a Master Mentor, but where there is no Master present, a Bureau Manager will be hired.
- Oversee operation of Bureaus Programs, Mentor Training, Rostering & Liaising.

VOLUNTEERS

Volunteering for cultural, community, and social programs positively impacts communities, promoting diversity, responsibility, and development.

It can help people in need and support local businesses, while also providing personal and professional benefits like meeting new people, gaining skills, and valuable experience.
